

**RESOLUTION NO. 1376  
CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF PORTIONS OF THE OLD STRYKER  
FIELD FOR THE PURPOSE BUILDING A LARGE-SCALE PLAYGROUND**

**Whereas**, the City of Prineville (“City”) owns property known as Stryker Park, which is part of the City of Prineville Park System; and

**Whereas**, The Crook County Parks and Recreation District (CCPRD), through an Intergovernmental Agreement, operates and manages Stryker Park; and

**Whereas**, CCPRD wishes to establish a large-scale playground within Old Stryker Field and desires approval from the City prior to seeking significant financial contributions; and

**Whereas**, City believes that the creation of large-scale playground within Old Stryker Field would enhance its City Park system and provide City residents with recreation that will contribute to the City’s health, fitness, and wellbeing; and

**Whereas**, both City and CCPRD recognize that negotiations would be required to address ongoing operational costs between CCPRD and the City.

**Now, Therefore**, the City of Prineville resolves as follows:

1. That the City has no objection to the use of the Old Stryker Field for the purpose of building a large-scale playground provided that CCPRD and City have an acceptable Intergovernmental Agreement prior to construction.
