APPLICATION FOR SOCIAL GAMING PREMISES LICENSE**

City of Prineville Ordinance 866 requires that no person who owns, manages or operates a private business, private club or place of public accommodation shall permit a social game between players at such a place without first securing a premises license for such purpose from the City Council.
