Located 2.2 miles west of Prineville on O'Neil Hwy. From town center, head west on US-26 (3rd St). Slight left on OR-126 W (signs for Redmond/Bend) and cross the bridge. Turn right onto OR-370 W (O'Neil Hwy). In 2.2 miles turn right onto Rimrock Acres Loop and the next left will take you to the Wetlands parking area.


