**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING CITY OF PRINEVILLE TO APPLY FOR 2019 TGM
GRANT**

Whereas, the City of Prineville (“City”) wishes to apply for a grant through the State of Oregon Transportation and Growth Management (“TGM”) for a State Highway Route Improvement Plan; and

Whereas, the City would like to embark on a planning project to determine the long term, all-encompassing solution to the traffic issues surfacing at four state highway intersections and along the section of State Highway 26 that serves as the main east-west thoroughfare of the City; and


Whereas, the project’s objective and expected outcome is to develop the implementation plan to facilitate the safe passage of vehicle, pedestrian and bicycle traffic through the Highway 126 and Highway 370 intersections with Highway 26, provide safe passage across the Crooked River Bridge on Highway 126, and solve the increasing capacity issues on Highway 26 through the City; and

Whereas, the City has prepared a Pre-Application for the 2019 TGM Grant to help fund the project; and

Whereas, the 2019 TGM Grant requires a resolution from Council endorsing the project;

Now, Therefore, the City of Prineville resolves to endorse the proposed State Highway Route Improvement Plan and further endorses the City to apply for the 2019 TGM Grant.
