MEMORANDUM

June 1, 1964

Subject: Proposed Amendment of Dangerous Building Ordinance

Section 203 of the 1958 Uniform Building Code adopted by Prineville Ordinance No. 491 provides a procedure for removal of unsafe buildings. The proposed amendment defeats the implication that Ordinance No. 436, an early procedure, is repealed. Ordinance No. 436 has been approved by the Supreme Court of Oregon in Why v. Marshfield, 138 Or. 167.

ORDINANCE NO. 567

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 436.

The people of the city of Prineville, Oregon, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 436 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Every building or part thereof which shall hereafter be found by the common council to be a dangerous building, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and the same may be abated either summarily or the procedure hereinabove specified may be followed, or a suit for abatement thereof may be brought by the city of Prineville in the circuit court of Crook County, Oregon. The procedures set forth in this ordinance are in addition to and exclusive of procedures provided in other ordinances of the city that relate to dangerous or unsafe buildings."
