

ORDINANCE NO. 847

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO RECEIVE REVENUE FROM THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Oregon has provided for the apportionment of certain revenues to the cities of the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, such legislation provides that a city, in order to participate in the sharing of those certain revenues, must express an election to receive such funds, which election must be made prior to July 31st of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville desires to receive a portion of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Prineville does hereby elect to receive its proportionate share of the revenues to be apportioned to the cities by the State of Oregon for the fiscal year 1981-82, and the City Administrator/Recorder of the City of Prineville is directed to take such steps as are necessary to carry out the intent of the ordinance.

Section 2. The Council finds that an emergency is hereby declared to exist in that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary for the health, peace and safety of the residents of the City of Prineville, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
