

ORDINANCE NO. 849

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 570, PRESCRIBING RULES OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Rule 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Rule 3. Committees. The following standing committees shall be appointed by the Mayor at the beginning of the year, each committee is to consist of three members selected from the City Council with the exception of the Industrial Development Committee, which shall be made up as described below, to wit:

1. Railroad and Finance Committee.
2. Public Works Committee (which includes sewer, streets, fire and ambulance, parks, recreation, water and lights.
3. Police, Judiciary and Licensing Committee.
4. Industrial Development Committee - said committee shall consist of two Council Members and one citizen at large.

All special committees shall be appointed by the presiding officer, unless otherwise ordered by the Council."


2. All other sections of Ordinance No. 520 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Inasmuch as it is necessary for health, safety and welfare of the City of Prineville that this ordinance go into effect immediately after its passage, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.


