

ORDINANCE NO. 903

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 865; ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE AMBULANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Charges for use of the City of Prineville ambulance shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

1. City Residents.....Base Rate \$100.00 plus \$4.00 per mile one way.
2. Non-City Residents..Base Rate of \$150.00 plus \$4.00 per mile one way.

Section 2. Standby Time:

1. Hospitals or Clinics: Standby time at hospitals or clinics while waiting for patient to have tests shall be charged at the rate of \$60.00 per hour, to be figured in 10 minute increments.

2. Sporting Event Standby:

(1) Tax-Supported Event (Football games, etc.) - \$30.00 base charge, plus \$5.00 per hour standby time, with base charge going to the City and hourly charge going to Volunteer Ambulance Drivers Fund.

(2) Non-Tax Supported Event (Rodeos, Horse Races, Horse Shows, etc.) - \$50.00 base charge plus \$10.00 per hour standby time, with base charge going to the City and hourly charge going to the Volunteer Ambulance Drivers Fund. Mileage to an out-of town event (e.g. Paulina Rodeo) will be charged at the rate of \$4.00 per mile one way in addition to the base rate and hourly charge.


Section 3. Ordinance No. 865 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the City of Prineville that this ordinance go into effect immediately after its passage, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
