

ORDINANCE NO. 946

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE  
AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 731

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Uniform Fire Code. There is hereby adopted by the City of Prineville, Crook County, Oregon, for the purposes of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the Uniform Fire Code recommended by the Western Fire Chiefs Association and the International Conference of Building Officials, being particular the 1988 Edition with the 1989 amendments and its appendix chapters in their entirety thereof, of which code not less than (3) copies have been and are now filed in the office of the recorder of the city of Prineville; and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein; and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provision thereof shall be controlling to all entities that contract with or are within the jurisdiction of the Prineville Fire Department.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 731 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
