

ORDINANCE NO. 961

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 866, REGULATING SOCIAL GAMES.**

**The people of the city of Prineville ordain as follows:**

**Section 1.** Section 3 of Ordinance No. 866 is amended to read:

**"Section 3. Application for Premise License.**

(1) No person who owns, manages, or operates a private business, private club, or place of public accommodation shall permit a social game between players at a place without first securing a premise license for such purpose from the city council.

(2) The cost of a premise license shall be \$100 annually. There shall be no pro rata refund of the fee if the license is revoked.

(3) Application for a premise license shall include the following:

(a) Name of proposed licensee, date of birth, social security number, ODL number or other acceptable identification, location of place of business, place of residence for the past five (5) years, and any criminal records.


(b) The type or types of social games to be played, number of participants, number of gaming tables to be used, and maximum betting of game.

(4) The premise license issued under this section shall not be assignable or transferable. A change in ownership of licensed business shall require a new application for license.

(5) The premises shall provide all cards and gaming equipment.
