

ORDINANCE NO. 974

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 576, SIDEWALKS.

The people of the city of Prineville ordain as follows:


Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 576 is amended to read:

"Section 2. When the city council considers it expedient to order the construction or repair of a sidewalk within the city, it shall declare its intention by ordinance. The ordinance shall specify the particular sidewalk or sidewalks to be constructed or repaired, the character of construction or repair, the grades and locations and specifications for materials and construction, and the time within which the owner or owners of the lots, blocks, or parcels of land are required to construct or repair the sidewalks. The ordinance shall also specify the names of the owners or reputed owners of the abutting lots, blocks, or parcels of land, or portions thereof, and shall particularly describe the lots, blocks, or parcels of land or portions thereof abutting upon the sidewalk or sidewalks. If the owner or owners fail to construct or repair the sidewalk within 30 days after passage of the ordinance, the council may cause the sidewalk to be constructed or repaired, and the cost shall be reported to the council by the city recorder within 10 days after the completion thereof. Immediately upon passage of the ordinance requiring construction or repair of sidewalks, the city recorder shall give notice of the passage of the ordinance and the requirements for construction or repair of the sidewalks to the owners or reputed owners of the lots, blocks, or parcels of land, or parts thereof, described in the ordinance. Notice shall be given by mailing written notice to each of them at their last known address by United States first-class mail or by publishing notice in one issue of a newspaper published in the city. Proof of mailing or publication shall be made by affidavit filed with the city recorder."

Section 2. Sections 4 and 6 of Ordinance No. 576 are repealed.
