

**ORDINANCE NO. 1082**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRANSIENT LODGING  
TAX ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

The People of the City of Prineville Ordain as follows:


Ordinance No. 837 shall be amended as follows:

1. As a matter of clarification, Ordinance 837 was amended by Ordinance No. 938.
2. The transient tax described in Section 2 of Ordinance 837 shall be increased to 9% of the rent charged by the operator.
3. The following Section (d) shall be added to Section 5 as an exemption from the tax:  
(d) An employee of the federal government, while on federal business, whose room is procured and paid for directly by the federal government through a purchase order or other form of procurement and with a government check. If the federal employee pays for the room personally, the employee is not exempt. The tax must be paid, even if the employee is in Prineville on federal business.

In all other respects, Ordinance No. 837 shall remain in full force and effect.

An emergency is deemed to exist, and this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and notification of the operators by the City of Prineville.
