WHEREAS, a three year serial levy for law enforcement in Crook County is scheduled to go in front of the voters May 17, 1994, and




WHEREAS, the failure of this levy could cause significant adverse impact on the public safety and the ability of the Sheriff's office to protect the public and house criminals,
