A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH
CROOK COUNTY INVOLVING THE CENTRAL HOUSING OF LAW
ENFORCEMENT AND SHARING OF SUPPORT STAFF


WHEREAS, Crook County Sheriff's department and the Prineville Police department have expressed a desire to be housed in a central location and share support services for a more efficient operation of law enforcement in Crook County, and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated the central housing of the law enforcement and support staff shall be located in the Prineville Police department area, and

WHEREAS, this central housing and sharing of support staff is dependent upon the passage of the three-year serial levy going before the voters May 17th,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DOES RESOLVE to support an interagency agreement for central housing and sharing of support staff.
